

Office Visit Forms Overview

Description and Importance

Office visit forms contains all the essential paper-and-pencil forms required to complete an adult ADHD evaluation. It includes intake documentation, informed consents, structured data collection forms, questionnaires, and billing sheets. You will only need to print this packet—no additional forms are necessary. These forms were designed to be clear, efficient, and legally compliant, supporting both clinical accuracy and streamlined documentation.

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List and Description of Forms

1. Informed Consent for Adult ADHD Evaluation

Outlines the purpose, structure, and components of the evaluation, including interviews, rating scales, and neurocognitive testing. Describes risks, confidentiality, and voluntary participation. Client signature required.

2. Informed Consent for Electronic Transmission of Report

Documents the client's consent to receive the completed ADHD evaluation report via encrypted email, with the password provided by text message. Includes risk disclosure and contact verification.

3. Office Visit Interview Form

Gathers identifying information, referral source, current medications, ADHD history, reasons for the evaluation, personal strengths, and behavioral observations.
